ORDER

Appellant moves the Court to enjoin Appellees from enforcing Connecticut gambling laws against Appellant. Appellees oppose the motion and request leave to file a full opposition by August 24, 2026.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, to the extent Appellant moves for a temporary injunction pending review by a three-Judge panel, the motion is DENIED. The motion for an injunction is referred to a three-Judge panel, to be heard in tandem with Appellant's motion for an injunction in *KalshiEX LLC v. Williams*, No. 26-1835. Appellees' motion for leave to file a full opposition by August 24, 2026 is GRANTED. Appellant may file a full reply in the ordinary course.
